The petitioners have approached this Court seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to complete the investigation pertaining to DDR No.36 dated 9.6.2018 (Annexure P-4), which was lodged at the instance of petitioner No.1 as a cross-version in FIR No.54 dated 9.6.2018 registered at Police Station Kamboj, District Amritsar under Sections 307, 326, 324, 325, 323, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code.

The learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that FIR No.54 dated 9.6.2018 was lodged at the instance of Major Singh (respondent No.4), wherein nine accused namely Raj Kumar, Manoj Kumar, Ajit Singh, Vijay Kumar, Raj Kumari, Chanchal Singh, Gurbaj Singh, Subegh Singh and Balkar Singh were nominated. The learned counsel has submitted that infact the genesis of occurrence has been suppressed inasmuch as accused/petitioners Raj Kumar and Vijay Kumar had also sustained injuries and who were got medico legally examined. The learned counsel in this

context has referred to MLR (Annexure P-7) in respect of Raj Kumar and MLR (Annexure P-8) in respect of Vijay Kumar.

It has been submitted that although DDR No.36 dated 9.6.2018 was recorded as a cross-version at the instance of Raj Kumar but no action has been taken thereupon although challan in the main case arising out of FIR No.54 dated 9.6.2018 has already been presented.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar Rural to look into the matter and in case any cross-version has been lodged at the instance of petitioners in FIR No.54 dated 9.6.2018, the same be got duly investigated and be taken to a logical conclusion.

A copy of this order be sent to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar Rural so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously preferably within a period of six months from today.
