The petitioner-bank has approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, inter alia for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, declaring respondent No.2 to act in pursuance to the applications filed by the petitioner-bank under Section 14 of the Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002 (in short 'the Act').

2. It was pointed out that during the pendency of the writ petition, the District Magistrate has passed an order on an application filed under Section 14 of the Act.

3. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner-bank submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to file fresh one with appropriate prayer.
