Petitioner has filed this petition with following prayer:-

“Petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to the respondent No.1 to 3 i.e. official respondents not to unnecessary harass and humiliate the petitioner in the name of the petitioner having previous criminal record and the premises of the petitioner are being searched by the police officials and every endeavour has been made on their behalf in order to arrest the petitioner without there being any reason for the same, in the name of maintaining law and order in Lok Sabha elections which is going to started from 11.04.2019.

Further it is prayed that as per the provisions of Section 160 of the Code of Cr.P.C., in case the petitioner is required to be interrogated in any manner, notice may be given to him for atleast 7 days, in the interest of justice.

Any other order or direction which this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper may also be passed in favour of petitioner.”

There are various equally efficacious remedies available to the petitioner including filing an application before the concerned Judicial Magistrate.

Hence, petitioner is relegated to the alternative remedy open to him.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.
