The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure (in short, “Cr.P.C”.) for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.33 dated 24.1.2019 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 354-A, 506 of Indian Penal Code (for short, “IPC”) and 8 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act at Police Station Sadar Gohana, District Sonapat.

Heard.

The allegations levelled against the petitioner is that he had been stalking and harassing a minor girl of 17½ years of age. Due to this, she had took some poisonous substance and started vomiting.

The petitioner is stated to be in custody since 27.1.2019.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long

ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the prior permission of the Court.
