Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.44 dated 06.06.2018, under Sections 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Mallanwala, District Ferozepur.

While issuing notice of motion, this court passed the following order on 16.08.2018:-

“It has been submitted that an amount of Rs.10,00,000/- was received by Kaur Singh, husband of the petitioner, on the pretext of arranging permanent visa for the son of complainant who was already in Australia. It has been further submitted that the only allegation against the petitioner is that at the time of advancing money, she was present.

Notice of motion for 15.01.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the Arresting/Investigating Officer. On doing so, she shall be released on interim bail, subject to her furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of

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Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, she shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. failing which she shall loose the benefit of interim bail allowed to her.”

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Paramjit Singh, has acknowledged that in terms of the previous order the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required in this case.

In view of above, the interim order dated 16.08.2018 is made absolute, subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the present petition stands disposed off.
