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**ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)**

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in NCB Crime No.31 dated 22.05.2017, under Sections 8, 18, 29, 60 & 62 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station NCB, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the alleged recovery of 4.5 kgs of opium has been effected from a bag being carried by the petitioner and the co-accused. The petitioner is in custody for over 2 years and is not involved in any other case. He is suffering from skin cancer which is evident from the copy of the medical report which is annexed as Annexure R-1 with the affidavit of the Superintendent of Prisons, Sirsa.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 2 years and is suffering from skin cancer, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
