This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.25 dated 13.01.2019 registered under Sections 379-A IPC at Police Station City Yamunanagar, District Yamunanagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that similarly situated co-accused was granted regular bail vide order passed in **CRM-M-10060-2019** dated 18.03.2019 titled as ***Raj Pal Vs. State of Haryana.*** Since the complainant and his wife had filed affidavits stating that he and the petitioner was not the person who had snatched the purse.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Omveer Singh has accepted this fact.

In the circumstances, I see no reason to take a different view for the petitioner and consequently, grant him the concession of regular bail in the same terms as in the above mentioned cases.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
