Petitioner Sushil Kumar has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.208 dated 30.10.2018, registered at Police Station Canal Colony, Bathinda, under Sections 458, 323 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code (Sections 109 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code was added later on).

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 12.04.2019, passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. He is not required for custodial interrogation. No useful purpose would be served by sending him to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present

case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 12.04.2019, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
