AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 06.04.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No.8632 of 2018.

The relevant portion of the order is reproduced below:-

“4. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in legal notice dated 03.10.2017 (P-5) and to take a conscious decision in accordance with law within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.”

Reply was filed annexing order dated 01.07.2019

whereby legal notice has been decided.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of reply filed no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition. However, he seeks liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law against the order passed.

The contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.

The rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
