RAJ SHEKHAR ATTRI, J.(Oral)

This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that statement under Section 164 Cr.P.C. is not available with him and it might be with the police. It has been submitted that although FIR has been registered but no proper investigation has been conducted.

Learned counsel for petitioner submits that he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the concerned authorities to consider and decide complaint/representation (Annexure P-3 and P-4) in a time bound manner.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to State of Haryana to consider and decide complaint/representation (Annexure P-3 and P-4) by passing a speaking order within a period of 30 days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. He is further directed to submit status report before concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate who will monitor the investigation in accordance with the guidelines laid down by Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Lalita Kumari v. Government of U.P. and others**; 2013 (4) RCR (Criminal) 979.
