On 11.04.2019, following order was passed:-

Kajal and Arjun, the petitioners before me, claim themselves to be major. They have pleaded that they have married against the wishes of respondent nos.4 to 6 and seek protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondents no.4 to 6. They have placed on record photographs Annexure P-3 evidencing their marriage. The petitioners have made representation dated 08.04.2019, Annexure P-5 to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, respondent no.2.

Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab, appearing for the State of Punjab is requested to submit a status report. A copy of the petition be supplied to the State counsel during the course of the day.

In the meantime, respondent no.2 would examine the threat perceptions and if found necessary, interim protection would be provided to them. It is made

clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them.

Adjourned to 24.04.2019.

In response to the aforesaid order, a status report by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Patti, District Tarn Taran, has been filed along with statements of the petitioners as also of respondents no.4, 5 and 6.

Keeping in view the status report, the present petition is disposed of. However, petitioners would be at liberty to move fresh application, in case, they feel that there is any apprehension to their life and liberty.
