Present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.92 dated 19.03.2018, under Sections 323, 324, 325, 326, 341, 427, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Nissing, District Karnal.

This Court, while issuing notice of motion on 24.08.2018, stayed the arrest of the petitioner till the next date of hearing i.e. 17.10.2018.

On 17.10.2018, this Court passed the following order:-

“ Adjourned to 30.01.2019.

In the meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on ad interim bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) CrPC. ”

Today, learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the aforesaid orders and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

The aforesaid factual position is duly acknowledged by learned State Counsel, on instructions from A.S.I. Raj Kumar.

In view of above, interim order 17.10.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the present petition stands disposed off.

It is made clear that the petitioner shall fully co-operate with the Investigating Officer as and when called for further investigation.

The observations may not be considered as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
