On 12.04.2019, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the parties have already arrived at out of court settlement and the complainant has sworn in affidavit Annexure P-2 to that effect.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab and seeks time to get instructions.

Mr. Gurminder Singh, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2 and admit the correctness of the assertions made.

Adjourned to 29.04.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when

called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Prem Chand, has submitted that the petitioners in this case have joined the investigation and they are not required for further custodial interrogation. He further submitted that the complainant/respondent No.2 has also entered into a settlement.

In view thereof, interim order dated 12.04.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
