GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. Petitioners – Samita and Sumit Kumar have averred that they have married against wishes of respondents No.4 to 7, who are parents and brother of petitioner No.1. The petitioners have annexed copies of their Aadhar Cards indicating that the petitioners are aged 27 years and 23 years, respectively.
2. The petitioners apprehend threat to their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7 and thus seek issuance of appropriate directions.

3. The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh to look into the representation (Annexure P-5) made by petitioners, in accordance with law, immediately upon receipt of certified copy of this order. In case any serious apprehension of threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners is found, requisite steps be taken immediately, in accordance with law, to protect life and liberty of the petitioners.
4. However, the aforesaid order shall not be taken to be any expression regarding validity of the alleged marriage of the parties.
