ANIL KSHETARPAL, J (ORAL)

On 11.04.2019, the following order was passed:-

“Manisha and Tinku, the petitioners before me, claim themselves to be major. They have pleaded that they have married against the wishes of respondent nos.4 to 8 and seek protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondents no.4 to 8. They have placed on record photographs Annexure P-3 evidencing their marriage. The petitioners have made representation dated 08.04.2019, Annexure P-5 to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, respondent no.2.

Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab, appearing for the State of Punjab is requested to submit a status report. A copy of the petition be supplied to the State counsel during the course of the day.

In the meantime, respondent no.2 would examine the threat perceptions and if found necessary, interim protection would be provided to them. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them.

Adjourned to 25.04.2019.”

Sh. Jiwan Lal, HC who is present in Court on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 has stated that the petitioners as well as respondents No.4 to 8 have suffered a statement before the police accepting the marriage and with assurance that no harm shall be caused to the petitioners. The petitioners have also suffered a statement that they do not require any police protection.

In view of the statement made, the petition is disposed of as infructuous.
