AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 17.11.2018 passed by this Court in CRM-M No.48362 of 2018.

The relevant portion of the order is reproduced below:-

“In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka to submit the progress report within a period of 04 weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order before concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate who will monitor the investigation in accordance with the guidelines laid down by Hon'ble Supreme Court in Lalita Kumari v. Government of U.P. and others; 2013 (4) RCR (Criminal) 979.”

The progress report dated 31.08.2019 has been produced today in the Court, same is taken on record. Copy of progress report is handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of progress report filed, no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition. However, he seeks liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law.

The contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous, with liberty as prayed for.

The rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
