Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.42 dated 22.6.2017, under Sections 323, 324, 506, 148 and 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Mehta, District Amritsar Rural, on the basis of compromise allegedly arrived at between the parties, wherein it is alleged that the compromise has been effected with the intervention of the elderly persons in the village. It is also highlighted that whatever statement is to be made by respondent No.2 in the Court of law, the same shall be made.

Vide order dated 29.1.2018, the notice of motion was issued and the parties were directed to get their statements recorded on 21.2.2018 with regard to the compromise.

Pursuant to the order dated 29.1.2018 report of the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Baba Bakala Sahib, District Amritsar has been received, which indicates that the complainant has not appeared and therefore, his statement could not be recorded. Already a period of one year has elapsed but neither there is any application moved on behalf of complainant/respondent No.2 nor by the accused persons to get the statement recorded pursuant to the compromise. It is apparent that the complainant has not consented to the compromise.

In view of the above, the petition is dismissed.
