Petitioner-Kuldeep Singh has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.162, dated 22.07.2017, under Sections 120-B, 419, 420, 465, 467, 468 and 471 IPC, Police Station City Faridkot, District Faridkot.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned State counsel assisted by learned counsel for complainant appeared and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel assisted by learned counsel for the complainant and have carefully gone through the record.

In compliance of interim order dated 28.05.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined investigation. He is not required for any custodial interrogation. No useful purpose would be served by sending the petitioner to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and further without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court finds merit in this petition and the same is allowed. Order dated 28.05.2019, granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as enshrined in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
