RAMENDRA JAIN, J. (ORAL):

Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing FIR No.52 dated 17.04.2014, registered under Sections 324/323/148/149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) Police Station Adampur and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (P-2).

In compliance of the order dated 08.05.2019 passed by this Court, the original receipt for an amount of Rs.15,000/- has been produced in the Court today. The same is taken on record. It be tagged at an appropriate place.

Pursuant to order dated 08.05.2019 of this Court, the parties appeared before the trial Court on 21.09.2018 along with receipts of ₹15,000/- to get their statements recorded. Learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jalandhar, has submitted his report vide letter bearing No.58 dated 16.02.2019, duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Jalandhar, vide Endst. No.488 dated 16.02.2018.

According to the report, ld. Judicial Magistrate Ist Class,

Jalandhar, is satisfied that compromise effected between the parties is genuine, voluntarily and without any pressure or undue influence. No accused has been declared as proclaimed offender.

Considering the report of Id. Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jalandhar, dated 16.02.2019 and the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony in relations between the parties, aforesaid FIR No.52 dated 17.04.2014 along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, is quashed qua the petitioners only.

Disposed of accordingly.
