Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.756 dated 23.10.2018 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 506 IPC (Section 326 IPC was added later on), registered at Police Station Sadar Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar.

While granting interim bail to petitioner No.1-Amit, following order was passed by this Court on 12.04.2019 :-

“Counsel for the petitioners, at the very outset, submits that since petitioner No.2 namely Parmod, against whom Section 326 IPC injury is attributed, stands arrested, the petition qua him may be dismissed as withdrawn.

Ordered accordingly.

Counsel for petitioner No.1 has submitted that before

adding Section 326 IPC, the petitioners were granted regular bail by the Illaqa Magistrate and after 06 months of the incident, now Section 326 IPC has been added and petitioner No.1 is sought to be arrested. It is further submitted that petitioner No.1 is ready to join the investigation and face the proceedings, in accordance with law.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioner No.1-Amit has joined the investigation and he is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Pardeep, has not disputed the factual position and states that petitioner No.1 Amit is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to petitioner No.1 Amit vide order dated 12.04.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
