Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondent Nos. 1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and their family members at the hands of respondent Nos. 7 to 20.

As per the averments made in the petition, the private respondents are involved in land grabbing and blackmailing the person and they are enjoying the protection of respondent No. 6, who is a habitual offender. It is further submitted that the petitioners have purchased some property and respondent No. 6, along with respondent Nos. 7 to 20, who is involved in nine FIRs as detailed in para 3 of the petition, is interfering in the possession of the petitioners over the land purchased by them.

Reply, filed by way of affidavit of DSP, Narwana, is on record and as per the same, petitioner No. 3 on 30.07.2016 gave a complaint to the police with the allegations that the private respondents are not allowing to go on to the land in dispute and on that account, DDR No. 34 dated 30.07.2016,

under Sections 107, 151 of Cr.P.C. was recorded against five persons. Thereafter, again a complaint was given by petitioner No. 3 and FIR No. 302 dated 19.11.2016, under Sections 506 and 34 of the IPC was registered in Police Station Sadar Narwana. It is also stated in the affidavit that respondent No. 6, who is lodged in District Jail, Jind in another FIR No. 240 dated 05.06.2016, under Sections 302, 307, 148, 149 and 120-B of the IPC read with Section 25 of the Arms Act, Police Station Safidon, was taken on production remand on 07.04.2017 and arrested in the present case. Thereafter, on the complaint given by petitioner No. 3, another FIR No. 121 dated 05.06.2018, under Sections 147, 149, 323, 341, 427, 447, 506 of the IPC was also registered at Police Station Sadar Narwana and again another FIR No. 195 dated 07.08.2018, under Section 506 IPC was registered against respondent No. 6.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Gurmail Singh, submits that in FIR No. 121, the accused have been arrested; challan stands presented and the charges have been framed.

Learned State counsel further submits that as and when a complaint regarding threat to life and liberty of the petitioners has been given, the police has taken action and has registered FIR against the accused persons and if some threat is extended to the petitioners even in future, the appropriate action will be taken against the accused persons, on receiving a complaint from the petitioners in this regard.

In view of the above, no further action is called for in the present petition and the same is disposed of accordingly.
