Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of the criminal complaint No. 373-1 of 2004, under Sections 3(K) (i), 17, 18, 29 and 33 of the Insecticides Act, 1968 as well as summoning order dated 23.12.2004 and all subsequent proceedings taken in the complaint.

During the course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that instead of challenging the quashing of complaint as well as summoning order dated 23.12.2004 he confines his prayer only to the extent of joining proceedings before learned trial Court. He further apprised the Court that in terms of the order of this Court dated 18.03.2019, the petitioner has joined the proceedings before learned trial Court and has filed the photocopy of the order dated 10.04.2019 passed by learned Senior Division Judicial Magistrate, Malout.

The prayer seems to be justified.

In view of the above,order dated 18.03.2019 is hereby made absolute and the present petition is disposed off at this stage with liberty to the petitioner to raise all pleas before learned trial Court at appropriate stage(s).
