This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.416 dated 21.08.2018 registered under Section 136 Indian Electricity Act (Amend) 2003 at Police Station Sadar Thanesar, District Kurukshetra.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has been in custody since 17.09.2018.

Custody certificate dated 13.05.2019 filed by way of affidavit of Resham Singh, Deputy Superintendent, District Prison (Kurukshetra), Haryana on behalf of State is taken on record. Copy supplied to the counsel opposite. As per custody certificate the petitioner has been in custody for 07 months & 16 days.

Learned State counsel states that the petitioner is involved in many similar cases.

Be that as it may and keeping in view the above facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner and without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate. It is however clarified that in case the petitioner does not file his bail bonds pursuant to this order, he will not be entitled to count any period of custody after today towards this case.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
