The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No.156 dated 31.12.2016 registered under Sections 457, 380, 411 IPC at Police Station City Dhuri, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in this very case, earlier the petitioner was granted anticipatory bail by the Court below. However, at that time, the petitioner could not arrange for the surety, therefore, he was taken into custody on 22.02.2019. Since then, the petitioner is in custody. Challan has already been filed. Therefore, the petitioner is not required for the investigation purposes.

On the other hand, learned State Counsel being instructed by ASI Pinjore Singh, submits that the petitioner is involved in a serious crime. However, it is not disputed that earlier the petitioner was granted even the concession of interim anticipatory bail.

In view of the above, but without commenting any further upon merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. It is ordered that the

petitioner be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/ sureties to the satisfaction of the trial Court/ Duty Magistrate.
