This is a petition filed under Section 438 Cr. P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.113, dated 18.07.2017 under Sections 323,324,452,148,149 IPC and lateron added Section 307,326 IPC Act registered at Police Station Lopoke, District Amritsar.
