This is a petition filed under Section 439 Cr. P.C. for grant of interim bail in case FIR No.653 dated 10.07.2018 under Sections 21-C and 25 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station City Sirsa, District Sirsa.

The petition has been filed pleading therein that the marriage of brother-in-law of the present petitioner, namely, Sunil Sukheeja, is fixed for 19.04.2019. Being the husband of the only sister of Sunil Sukheeja, the petitioner is required to participate in the marriage to perform certain social ceremonies. Hence, prayer for interim bail for a short duration is made.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned counsel for the State, being instructed by ASI Satyaveer Singh, submits that the factum of marriage of brother-in-law of the petitioner has been verified and it has been found to be factually correct. A report prepared by the above said ASI Satyaveer Singh, to this effect, is also produced before the Court.

In view of the above, it would not be unjustified, if the petitioner is granted interim bail for a short duration.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that the petitioner be released on interim bail for a period of 08 days on furnishing bail bonds/surety to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

It is further ordered that the petitioner shall surrender before the trial Court/authorities on 25.04.2019.
