Petitioner-Satbir Singh has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of direction to the official respondent Nos.2 and 3 to not to harass the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that respondent Nos.4 and 5 are harassing him whereas perusal of the representation does not make out a convincing ground to believe the stand of the petitioner.

The alleged cheque dated 29.03.2019 was issued by Jasbir Singh @ Jassi (respondent No.5) in favour of the petitioner and the representation allegedly is given on the next date i.e.30.03.2019, as apprised by learned counsel.

Considering the pleadings in the petition as well as the representation, no case is made out of invoking inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Petition is dismissed.
