Surinder Kumar has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 for transferring the investigation of case FIR No.0243 dated 08.12.2018 registered under Sections 302, 134 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code and Sections 25, 27, 54 and 59 of Arms Act.

During the course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner has fairly stated that one of the suspects, namely, Jatinder Singh @ Bholu already stands arrested and qua him the investigation is also complete. The challan against him already stands filed by the Police. It is not disputed by learned counsel that the deceased had enmity with Jatinder Singh @ Bholu, upon whom suspicion was expressed in the FIR. It is also pointed out that another accused also stands arrested, however his name is not known to the petitioner.

At this stage, it will not be appropriate to comment upon the

merits of the case as the investigation is still pending.

In view of the fact that investigation qua one of the accused is complete and regarding another it is pending, therefore, it will not be appropriate to invoke inherent powers at this stage. Resultantly, no convincing ground is made out for transferring the investigation of the case to some independent agency.

Dismissed, at this stage.
