AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The writ petition filed by the petitioner was allowed in view of decision of this Court in CWP No.26520 of 2014 titled as ***Kulbir Singh Vs. Pepsu Road Transport Corporation and another.*** In the said writ petition, it was directed that pensionary benefits be released to the petitioner as early as possible but not later than six months and further that interest @ 9% per annum be awarded from the date of retirement of the petitioner till the payment is actually made.

Short reply by way of affidavit of Gurlovleen Singh Sidhu,

Managing Director, Pepsu Road Transport Corporation, Patiala is filed today in the Court, same is taken on record. Copy of reply is handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner. As per affidavit, interest on delayed payment of gratuity, leave encashment and GPF has been paid.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is not in a position to dispute the said fact. However, he seeks liberty to challenge the calculation.

The contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous, with liberty as prayed for.

The rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.
