ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J.(ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.26 dated 14.03.2019 under Sections 420, 120-B and 506 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Meharban, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner in the FIR are that although the petitioner had entered into an agreement to sell with the complainant but the physical possession of the plot measuring 81 sq. yards was not handed over to the vendee (complainant). He, however, contends that after the sale-deed was executed, mutation was entered and sanctioned in favour of the complainant. However, the original land owner from whom the petitioner had purchased the said land in the year 2017 had not parted with the physical possession. The petitioner is a lady of 36 years in age with two minor children and is not involved in any other case.

This Court, by the order dated 22.04.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the

investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurinder Singh states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the order dated 22.04.2019 granting ad interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
