FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Report dated 09.10.2018 of learned Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Panchkula has been received whereby after recording statements of complainant Nisha and the accused person, namely Gurjeet Singh the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise (Annexure A3) has been arrived at voluntarily, out of free will of the parties, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Moreover, during the course of interaction with the parties, they have shown their resolve to end the dispute and have made statements that they have compromised the matter as per compromise (Annexure A3) dated 18.09.2018 and shall abide by the same.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court and the parties being officials of the same very department and the offenses for which the accused has been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh v. State of Punjab and another**' 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No.30 dated 22.05.2016 under Sections 294, 295, 354(A)(1), 506 and 511 IPC pertaining to Women Police Station, Panchkula and all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioner are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
