The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 28.11.2018 passed in CWP No. 30028 of 2018.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

"Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the legal notice dated 13.08.2018 (Annexure P-4), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 13.08.2018 (Annexure P-4) within a period of three months from the receipt of copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled to any monetary benefits after the decision of the legal notice, the same should also be paid to the petitioner within three months thereafter."

A speaking order has been produced today in Court, copy handed over to counsel for the petitioner.

It is stated that the claim of the petitioner has been accepted, the petitioner has been found entitled to pension and for arrears only after 1.1.2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he is not in a position to dispute the fact that the claim of petitioner has been accepted and arrears has been paid.

In view of the above, the contempt petition is rendered infructuous. However, it is made clear that in case fresh cause of action arises with regard to non-payment of amount, liberty is granted to the petitioner to avail remedy in accordance with law.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.
