AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This is a petition for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.153 dated 19.05.2018 registered under Sections 420/387/120-B IPC at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala.

On 20.08.2018 the following order was passed:-

“Submits that the money has been received in the account of the husband of the petitioner and his father Hari Krishan.

Notice of motion.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the police and join investigation within a week. In the event of her arrest being required, she shall be released on interim bail till the next date, subject to her furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of SHO/Investigating Officer. However, she shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under

Section 438(2) Code of Criminal Procedure failing which she shall lose the benefit of interim bail allowed to her.

To be heard along with CRM-M-27458-2018..”

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Harjinder Singh accepts the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Resultantly, the petition is allowed. The interim order dated 20.08.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
