The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.87 dated 16.05.2016 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 307, 506 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, at Police Station Nagina.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the matter has been amicably settled between the parties. He further submits that in any case, the petitioners are ready to join the investigation.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. M.D. Sharma, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State. Mr. Naveen Sharma, Advocate appears for the complainant.

Learned counsel for the complainant also does not dispute the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties.

In view of the above submissions, however, without commenting upon merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. The petitioners are granted concession of anticipatory bail. Therefore, it is directed that in case of their arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail

by the Investigating Officer subject to their furnishing bail bonds/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of Investigating Officer. However, it is further directed that the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when so required by the Investigating Officer. They shall further comply with the conditions stipulated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
