Short reply of Shamsher Singh Dahiya, Superintendent Jail, Central Jail-I, Hisar on behalf of respondents No. 1 and 3 filed in Court today is taken on record.

Heard.

Petitioner seeks emergency parole under Section 3(1) (a) of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988 and also seeks quashing of the order dated 5.4.2019 (Annexure P-4), passed by respondent No. 2-The District Magistrate, Hisar whereby the application moved by the petitioner for grant of six weeks emergency parole to look after his wife, who is diagnosed with disease Proliferative Endometrium and was advised surgery, was declined.

Petitioner has referred to some test reports which mention that wife of the petitioner was diagnosed with Proliferative Endometrium. Report is dated 27.11.2018. However, there is nothing on record to show that any surgery was recommended by any surgeon and her surgery is required. The said test report shows some problem which could be recovered by medicines also. However, the surgery is conducted only in extreme cases. Therefore, ground that the surgery of the wife of the petitioner is required, is not proved.

Accordingly, there is no illegality or infirmity in the impugned order dated 5.4.2019 (Annexure P-4), passed by respondent No. 2-The District Magistrate, Hisar.

Petition is accordingly dismissed.
