ANIL KSHETARPAL, J. (ORAL) :

On 21.08.2018, while noticing the contentions of learned counsel for the petitioner, the following order was passed:

“ Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in the case, whereas, no offence is made out against him. Petitioner is not running any office or agency in the name and style of K.K. Travels. He is only the Managing Director of the Company. Learned counsel also submits that the petitioner is having a dispute with well known singer Jorawar Singh Randhawa alias Jora Randhawa. The complainant is a care taker of the house of said Jorawar Singh Randhawa alias Jora Randhawa situated at Jalandhar. A false FIR has been registered against the petitioner. The said amount was neither paid in cash nor deposited in the account. Petitioner is ready to join investigation.

Meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he shall be

released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer. He shall join the investigation as and when required by the Investigating Officer. He shall also comply with the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, which are as under :-

(i)that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation before investigating officer as and when required;

(ii)that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court or to any police officer;

(iii)that the petitioner shall not leave India without the prior permission of the Court.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Mr.Parveen Kumar, ASI, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and has also given the voice sample.

In view of the aforesaid, the petition is allowed and the order dated 21.08.2018 is made absolute.
