This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of direction to the official respondents to take legal action against respondent No.10 for illegal construction of sheds in the residential premises.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.3 – Deputy Director, Department of Local Bodies, Punjab to consider and decide the letter/ representation dated 15.7.2018 (Annexure P-18) expeditiously.

Heard.

A complete set of paper book has been handed over to Ms.Samina Dhir, DAG, Punjab in the Court today.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 – Deputy Director, Department of Local Bodies, Punjab to consider and

decide the letter/ representation dated 15.7.2018 (Annexure P-18) in accordance with law within six weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to her, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to her, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
