The writ petition filed by the petitioner was disposed of as the monetary benefits were released to the petitioner during the pendency of the writ petition. However, it was ordered that the petitioner shall be entitled to interest at the rate of interest of 7% per annum, from the date when each payment was due to him till the date payment was actually made. It was ordered that calculations of interest be made after hearing objections of the petitioner and thereafter, speaking order shall be passed.

The contempt petition is filed pleading that needful is not done.

Learned counsel for the respondents relying upon the pleadings in the reply, submits that an amount of ₹ 84,800/- has been paid to the petitioner for interest. However, he fairly submits that the calculations have not been provided to the petitioner nor the objections heard. On instructions from Ram Karan, SI, it is undertaken that the calculations would be provided to the petitioner within four weeks from today, thereafter, in case, he files any objections, the same would be considered and shall be

decided by passing a reasoned order. The needful would be done within four weeks, thereafter.

In view of the above, the contempt petition is disposed of. In case, any amount is found due after considering the petitioners' objections, the same shall be released within four weeks, thereafter

In case, the grievance of the petitioner still survives against the order passed, he would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law.
