The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.115 dated 5.8.2017, registered at Police Station Mataur, District Mohali, under Sections 406, 420 IPC read with Section 24 of Immigration Act, 1965.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has made payment to the complainant.

Learned State counsel submits that payment has allegedly been made to only one of the complainants i.e. Avdesh Kumar and there are 09 other complainants in this case, who have not been paid the money due to them.

Learned counsel for the complainant-Deepak Verma supports this assertion.

Learned State counsel further submits that there are a large number of other similar cases pending against the petitioner and he has been arrested in some of them.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has failed to make payment to all the complainants in the present case as well as the fact that

there are a large number of other cases with similar allegations pending against the petitioner, he does not deserve to be granted concession of anticipatory bail.

The petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
