ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.149 dated 02.08.2018, under Sections 467, 468, 471, 420, 406 and 506 IPC and Section 66(B) of Information Technology Act, 2000 registered at Police Station City Samana, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he had stolen the data of the company where he was working and is now utilising the same in the new company floated by him.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 21.08.2018, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to

the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Baljit Ram, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the order dated 21.10.2018 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
