The present petition was filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for issuance of direction and handing over investigation in case FIR No. 86 dated 27.04.2014 under Sections 15/61/85 NDPS Act, Police Station Samana, District Patiala, to an independent agency.

Notice of motion was issued on 13.10.2015 and thereafter on majority of the occasions the petitioner was not represented. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner today as well.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by ASI Puran, has apprised the Court that after completion of investigation in the case, challan was filed on 14.05.2018 and after framing of charges the trial proceeded further and three witnesses have already been examined by the prosecution.

Considering the stage of the trial, no case is made out for invoking the

inherent powers under Section 482 Cr. P.C.

Resultantly, the petition is dismissed.
