The present petition filed under Section 407 of the Code of Criminal Procedure ('Cr.P.C.') read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. for transfer of case No.14/05.01.2018 titled as State Vs. Lagan etc. in FIR No.004 dated 03.01.2017, under Sections 498-A, 406, 323, 34 of the Indian Penal Code pending in the court of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Rohtak to the court of competent jurisdiction of Gurugram.

Separate reply filed by learned State counsel and learned counsel for respondents No.2 and 3 are taken on record.

At the time of registration of the FIR, petitioner given her address of Rohtak. It has been asserted that now she has been shifted to Gurugram.

A bare perusal of list of witnesses (Annexure P-1) transpires that the material witnesses are residents of Rohtak.

In this view of the matter, no case is made out to transfer of case No.14/05.01.2018 titled as *State Vs. Lagan etc.*

However, petitioner is at liberty to appear and depose through video conferencing. For this purpose, she may approach to learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gurugram, who will arrange her appearance through video conferencing. She is also directed to appear along with her witnesses.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
