The petitioners have approached this Court by filing the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.83 dated 08.09.2016 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 323, 451, 506, 148 & 149 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Division No.3, Ludhiana and challan under Sections 323, 451, 506, 148 & 149 of Indian Penal Code along with all consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-3).

On the last date of hearing, this Court directed the parties to appear before the learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for recording their statements regarding compromise.

In compliance to the order dated 25.10.2018, report of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana has been received that both the

parties have recorded their statement and entered into compromise which is out of their free will and without any inducement or pressure.

In view of the nature of offence and the fact that the parties have effected compromise, the continuation of further proceedings will be useless exercise. As such, petition is allowed and FIR No.83 dated 08.09.2016 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 323, 451, 506, 148 & 149 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Division No.3, Ludhiana and challan under Sections 323, 451, 506, 148 & 149 of Indian Penal Code along with all consequential proceedings, stands quashed qua the petitioners.

Accordingly, petition is allowed.
