MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty from the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 6 who are parents and brother, respectively, of petitioner No.1.

It is not disputed that petitioner No.1 and private respondents are resident of Mumbai. The apprehension is founded on the alleged marriage entered into between the petitioners on 10.04.2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that representation stands given to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka on 10.04.2019 and a perusal of the same reveals that the petitioners were in love since long and decided to perform the marriage. Annexure P-5 is the death certificate of Maheshdaulat Ram Sharma with whom petitioner No.1 married previously who expired on 10.03.2019.

Considering the above facts and the conduct of petitioner No.1, this Court does not find any valid reason to invoke inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Resultantly, petition is dismissed.
