On 12.04.2019, following order was passed:-

“Mandeep Kaur and Gurpreet Singh, the petitioners before me, claim themselves to be major. They have pleaded that they have married against the wishes of respondent Nos.4 to 7 and seek protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondent Nos.4 to 7. They have placed on record photographs Annexures P-4 evidencing their marriage. The petitioners have submitted a representation dated 08.04.2019, Annexure P-5 to respondent no.2.

Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab, appearing for the State of Punjab is requested to submit a status report. A copy of the petition be supplied to the State counsel during the course of the day.

In the meantime, respondent No.2 would examine the

threat perceptions and if found necessary, interim protection would be provided to them. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them.

Adjourned to 29.04.2019.”

Status report by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, has been filed in which it has been stated that the petitioners have now given statement to the effect that they do not apprehend any danger or threat to their life and, therefore, they do not require any security.

In view of the aforesaid, the present petition is disposed of.
