Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in complaint No.99 dated 26.10.2017 (CIS No.CRM/220/2017) under Sections 376(2)(a), 323, 324, 325, 506 IPC pending in the court of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Mohali.

On 23.08.2018, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned Senior counsel states that the petitioner has been summoned in a complaint case and he is ready to appear before the Court below on 31.08.2018, the date fixed.

Notice of motion, returnable for 01.10.2018.

The petitioner is directed to appear before the summoning Court on 31.08.2018. On appearance he shall be

admitted to interim bail on his furnishing bail bond and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Court below.

A copy of the order be produced on the next date of hearing.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the aforesaid order, petitioner has appeared before trial court and has been admitted on interim bail.

Since the petitioner has appeared before the trial court and has been admitted on bail, the order dated 23.08.2018 passed by this Court is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall appear before the trial court regularly unless his personal appearance is not exempted.
