Present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.310 dated 19.12.2018 under Section 406, 420 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City Kapurthala, District Kapurthala.

Perusal of order dated 22.04.2019 reveals that time was sought to by learned counsel for the petitioner to get instructions whether the petitioner is ready to deposit the amount with the Court.

In terms of the order dated 22.04.2019, no amount has been deposited by the petitioner till date. Moreso, recovery of the loan amount to the tune of Rs.1,20,000/- is yet to be effected for which custodial interrogation of the petitioner is necessary. Therefore, no ground is made out for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Resultantly, the present petition is dismissed.
