The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondent No. 2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent Nos. 4 and 5. Further prayer is made for issuance of directions to respondents No. 3 to 5 to not to harass the petitioners and to supply the copy of complaint and the status of complaint filed by respondents No.4 and 5. It is also prayed that directions be issued to respondent No.2 to look into the representation dated 8.4.2019 filed by the petitioners.

Reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Mohit Agarwal, DSP (Detective), Sangrur filed in Court today. The same is taken on record.

It is pointed out by the learned State counsel, being instructed by Inspector Yadvinder Singh, that an FIR under Sections 421 and 120B IPC has been registered against petitioners No.1, 3 and 4. The petitioners have been

found involved in embezzlement of the money of the general public, including that of the respondents.

In view of the above, the present petition does not survive.
