**ANIL KSHETARPAL, J.**

Petitioner prays for regular bail in FIR No.47 dated 16.02.2018 registered under Sections 323, 324, 326, 341, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station, Rania, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is in custody since 02.02.2019. He further submits that on completion of investigation, police has filed its final report and charges have been framed. However, no evidence on behalf of the prosecution has been recorded till date.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the first informant-injured opposes the prayer made on the ground that this is third attempt by the petitioner. He submits that in the year 2013, petitioner had inflicted injury on the first informant, however, due to intervention of common relatives and respectables, the matter was patched up. He further submits that mother of the first informant has lodged FIR against the petitioner on 22.04.2017 under Sections 148/149/323/324/452/506 IPC and the present FIR is of 16.02.2018.

On a pointed question, learned counsel for the first informant has informed the Court that the petitioner is not a previous convict. All the cases are pending trial.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the aforesaid facts as also conclusion of the trial is likely to take time, it is considered appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate. However, liberty is granted to the victim/first informant to move an application for cancellation before the learned trial court if in future there is such attempt.
