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**MANOJ BAJAJ, J.(ORAL)**

Through this petition, filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioners have prayed for quashing of FIR No.50 dated 16.02.2011 for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 447, 448, 506 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the settlement arrived at between the parties with the efforts of Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. Attention of the Court is invited to Clause 8 (ii) wherein it is mentioned that party No.2 has no objection if FIR No.50 dated 16.02.2011 is quashed on the basis of the compromise.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant/respondent No.2 does not dispute this fact and states that indeed the compromise has been arrived at between the parties and he has no objection if the FIR is quashed.

In view of the above, present petition succeeds and FIR No.50 dated 16.02.2011 for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 447, 448, 506 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are ordered to be quashed.
